COMMITMENT

The time commitment for Oxnard Leadership includes 10 full day sessions, plus a 2 hour Welcome Reception and Graduation. Participants are expected to attend all 10 sessions. Classes will be held from 8:00am–4:00pm. Participants may miss no more than two sessions in order to graduate. TUITION

The full course investment of \$875 per participant covers the cost of all 10 classes, materials, food, graduation ceremony, and recognition plaque. Classes include: history, parks & museums; public services; government; media; public safety; education;
